

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is:

Squamish Trails Society

2. The purposes of the Society are:

- to enhance the quality of life in the District of Squamish by planning, constructing, and maintaining a public pedestrian and cycling system, using off-road routes wherever possible, which links all developed areas in the District

- to promote public use and support of the trail system

- to promote appreciation of our natural and cultural heritage

- to cooperate with the District of Squamish in the revision and implementation of the Official Community Plan

- to cooperate with other interested parties, organizations, and agencies in developing trails

3. The operations of the society are to be chiefly carried out in the District of Squamish.

4. On the winding up or dissolution of this Society, funds or assets remaining after all debts have been paid shall be transferred to a charitable institution with purposes similar to those of this society, or, if this cannot be done, to another charitable institution recognized by Revenue Canada as qualified under the provisions of Income Tax of Canada.

5. The purpose of the Society shall be carried out without purpose or gain for its members, and any profits or accretions to the society shall be used for promoting its purpose.

6. Paragraphs 4, 5, and 6 of this Constitution are irreversible in accordance with the Society Act.

BYLAWS
