Re. Temporary closure of the Nature Trail

Thank you for continuing to observe this temporary closure of the Nature Trail. It remains soft and muddy in some sections after work done in mid-November. The trail is beginning to dry and firm-up despite the weather and still needs to be crowned to better shed rainfall. Travelling on the trail through soft sections will necessitate further repairs and delay reopening the trail.

The Squamish Trails Society has matched these awarded grants to pay for the work completed thus far.
